safety margin

All text or content that cannot be lost to cutting must be inside this safety margin of 1/8"

cut line

Printed product cut here to the finish size

bleed area

Any artwork that touches the cut line must extend beyond to the red line. Note that the content in this bleed area will be cut off, however doing so ensures safe cutting (i.e. eliminating the chance of having an undesirable white border)
